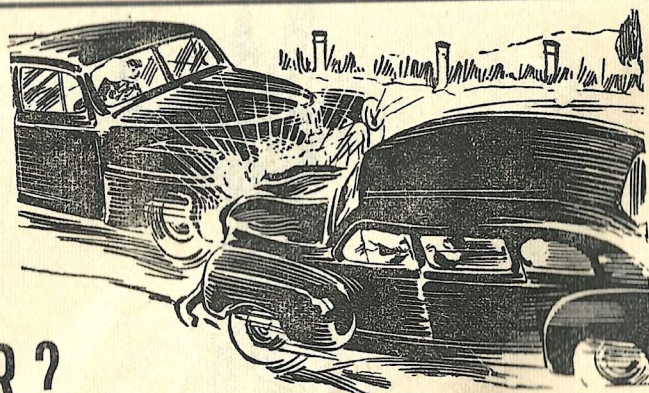

TODAY'S GAME

Once again Reservoir meet Wanderers - this time on the Wanderer's home territory. Last time they played Reservoir made a mess to coast home by thirty goals. With their eye on that flag which has eluded them now for twelve long seasons, Reservoir will be more than determined to show "who's the boss" and win by a great margin to prove that they are worthy of top position. On present form they should have little difficulty in attaining this as they are riding on the crest of a winning wave. Thirteen straight wins speaks for itself.

The forward line has now developed into a three pronged attack with the strong robust play of "Rocky" Rodda, perhaps the most effective centre half forward in the competition. "Wilberforce" Whittenbury claims that Bob Johnson is his protege, and with Nev Ward back in top form with last week he has shown that his hand is not worrying him.

Reservoir's rucks, headed by skipper Alan Chandler, who is playing better than ever, have not been tossed for quite some time and they certainly present a "king's size" problem to all comers. Backed by nippy rovers, "Babes-in-the WOODs", and Antonio Merrett, the "Red and Whites" pack plenty of punch around the packs.

The back line, which has only conceded 530 points in 15 games, would be the strongest defence fielded by Reservoir for years. Their understanding, talking, shepherding and robust play gives them a decided advantage, and they have established Reservoir to their present top rating.

Wanderers are the disappointing side this year, having registered only two victories. Reservoir with sounder construction and an impressive record should be untroubled to win.

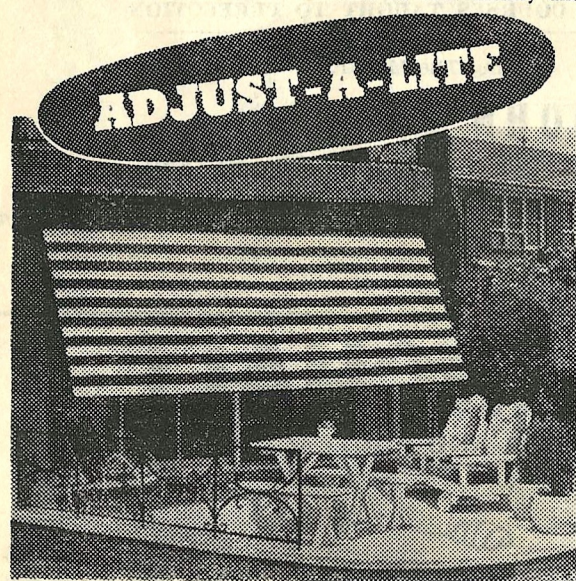

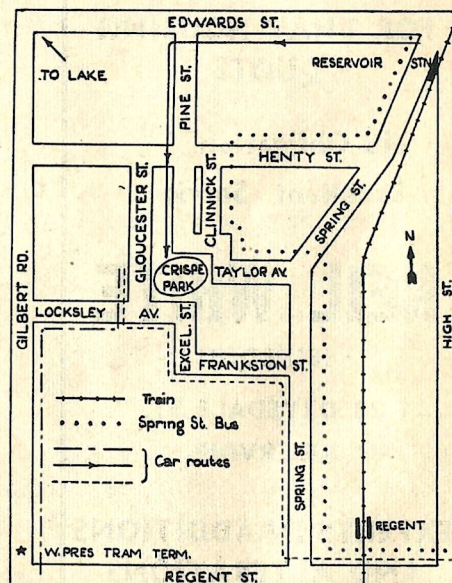

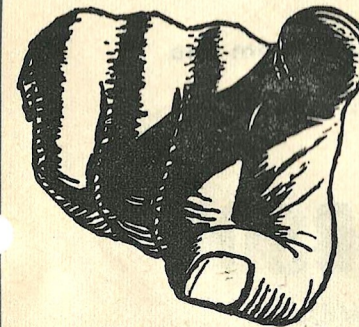
