
This Association has been duly registered and formed to protect Gas Consumers against indifferent supply and overcharge, consequent on defective and erroneous registration caused by faulty meters.

In cases where Subscribers may leave their houses for any period, notice should be at once sent to our Office, so that their interests may be narrowly watched during their absence. We should also be advised in the event of Subscribers changing residence.
The ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION is 10s. (payable in advance) where One Meter is used; 20s. where two Meters are in use; and an arrangement can be made where more are required.

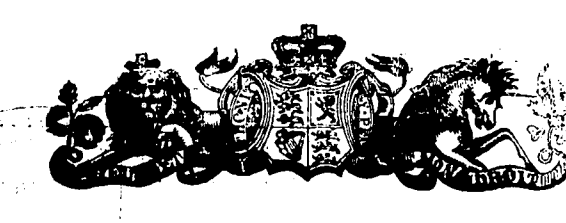
