INSIDE PARLIAMENT.

Mr. Murray has submitted his proposed vote of no confidence. His intention of the Ministry was practically confined to their railway and financial administration, and was generally considered weak—far weaker than we imagined it would be. Mr. Gillies's reply was a triumphant vindication of the Government. The result, from a party point of view, is that the Ministry's prospect is brightening. A meeting of the Opposition was held yesterday, at which the disaffected part in the Government corner were freely invited, but to our regret no account had been taken of Mr. Wheeler, who has been invited to resign the office of Secretary of the Railway Committee. Mr. Murray is probably about the only member who will vote for the Government on the proposed vote of no confidence. Yet Mr. Murray is the leader of the country party, and Mr. Wheeler could not afford to pass him by forming a new Ministry. The votes of the late majority of the Opposition will vote with the Ministry. Mr. Wheeler, Mr. Lawson, and Mr. Best have been in doubt on Tuesday, but unless a great change takes place they can no longer waver. A copy of the minutes of the meeting of the Opposition, reliable last prepared in the opposition room by the recognized leaders of the movement is before me. This shows that they do not expect more than forty-fives in all. They put out a circular at Simsbury. They are right in their opinion against the Government. Mr. Carter and Mr. Patten, but they are in favor of the Government. Mr. Wheeler, Mr. Carter, and Mr. Patten. Even Mr. Wheeler, the Opposition may make their own vote, will not necessarily vote in the direction of the Government. Mr. Wheeler is expected to support the Government. The debate will not be concluded until Thursday next.
