Campbell, as the council's nominee, had expired, and it was necessary to fill such vacancies; also to appoint two auditors.—Crs. Parsons and McLean were re-elected, Messrs. J. S. Whalley were re-elected auditors.

METROPOLITAN BOARD ENQUIRY. The Richmond town council were asking this council to send delegates to a conference to consider the question of urging the Government to appoint a Royal Commission to enquire into the working of the board. Cr. Yeomans was appointed to attend the conference.

AN OCCASIONAL CONCERT. Mrs. Jameson, M.A., principal of King's College, wrote requesting the council's patronage at an occasional entertainment in aid of the Children's Hospital, the same to take place a few evenings after the usual regular night.—Granted on the motion of Cr. O'Connell and McLean.

THE PRESTON SHIRE COUNCIL were forwarding their Report to the Standing Committee stating that they had complied with the Preston conference resolutions re taking evidence on the Young street tramway. Cr. Pearl thought the committee should have only been willing to receive evidence especially at the request of such an important conference.

Cr. Yeomans said that as the Northcote council had not endorsed the resolutions carried at the conference the conference had no right to put their names in the matter. It put them in a false position.

Cr. Yeomans—To put us right a letter should be sent to the Railways Standing Committee stating that we did not endorse the resolutions carried at the conference. Surely they were not going to let the conference do it due to T. Foley for ploughing the field.—Adopted.

THE NORTHCOTE MEETING. O. V. Sierakowski went forwarding the resolutions passed at the public meeting held at the Croxton railway station on the previous Wednesday evening. They favored the Young street route, and expressed regret that the majority of the Northcote council had supported a connection with the Collingwood line.

A motion was submitted that the resolutions be received. Cr. Dennis moved and Cr. Mark supported a resolution that they be not received.

The mayor ruled this out of order as a direct negative. Cr. Dennis asked if Croxton station was a duly convened public meeting. The Mayor—Not in a true sense. Cr. Pearl—A meeting called by advertisement and handbill was surely a public one.

The Mayor—All public meetings should be convened by the mayor of the town. Cr. Pearl—Certainly not. The Mayor—I rule it was not a public meeting.

Cr. Dennis supported the mayor in that it was not a duly convened meeting, and that the resolutions should not be received. Cr. Thompson supported the reception of the resolutions. The meeting evidently just wished to convey that they disapproved of the council's action.

Cr. McLean—They are entitled to their opinions just as much as we are. There was no need to cast a star on those gentlemen because they chose to call a meeting of that kind. He considered the meeting just as much a public meeting as if called by the Mayor. He would not object to it as a public meeting.

Cr. Pearl objected that it was unnecessary to offer to ask him to decide such a matter. The town clerk said the Act laid it down that the mayor should take precedence in all municipal proceedings.

Cr. Pearl—But these were not municipal proceedings. Cr. Yeomans said he discounted the result of a meeting very much when those promoting it had not the courage to ask the mayor to convene it. The motion for the reception of the resolutions was carried.

Cr. Pearl urged that they should endeavor to get the Railway Department to construct the street. Public speaking they were liable to do so. Cr. Marks said that since the letter was written the street had been put in a very fair condition.

Cr. Dennis suggested a deputation to the railway authorities. They had just as good a chance of getting this right-of-way constructed. A MEMBER'S LICENSES. John Vale, Secretary Victorian Alliance wrote requesting the council to issue a representative on the Metropolitan Board of Works to oppose the granting of a hotel license on the acreage farm, Wurribee.
