PRESTON SHIRE COUNCIL. TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 29TH. Present.—Crs. Howe (president), Nichol, Staines, Newton, Braithwaite, Crisp, and Drege.

THE GREAT ARAB. Kelly Brook and Ziebell were asking that their policy be put in line with other local hand and race-acting factors and excluded from the meet area.

AN APPLICATION. W. Braithwaite was asking that crickets be substituted for snooker events at the entrance to his factory, as the latter would be a disadvantage in carrying loads to and from the premises.

CR. BRAITHWAITE said he was willing to pay any portion of the cost of the work the council deemed fit and equitable.

CR. DREGE moved and Cr. Newton seconded that the application be granted. Referring to Cr. Crisp the engineer said the cost of the crickets would be about £25.

CR. BRAITHWAITE said he was willing to pay half the cost or as much more as the council deemed advisable to charge him.

CR. CRISP raised the point that the crickets might affect the flow of the drainage. The engineer said he would have preferred to have had no crickets, but that was impossible, at any rate on the south side.

FEMALE REHABILITATE. Some little time ago the Northcote Reformatory had a discussion on the advisability of forming a female benefit society, the outcome being a committee was formed with the object of ascertaining how many members were likely to be secured.

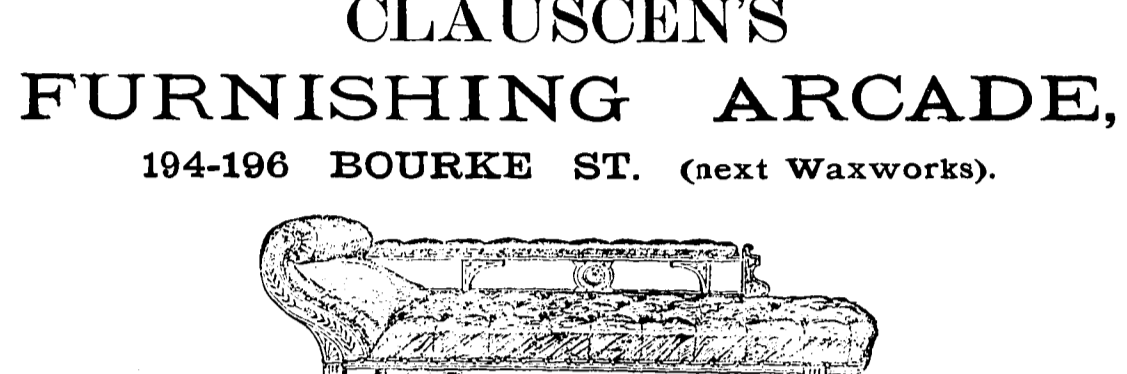
