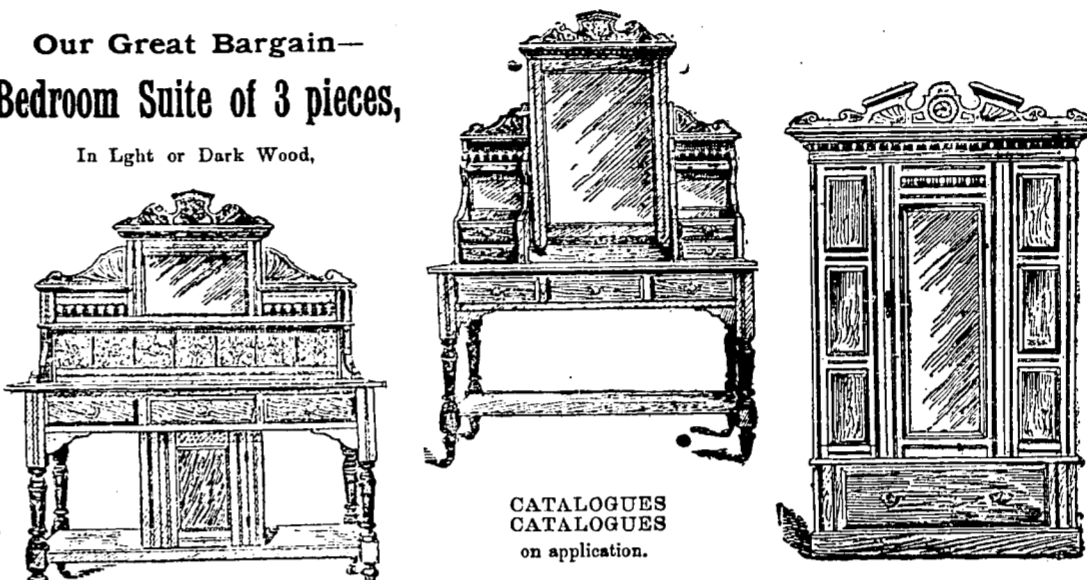

WHAT I WOULD DO IF I WERE A FARMER. By Rev. Charles M. Sheldon, Theophanes Kan. From a paper read before the Agricultural Society of the Kansas State of Agriculture.
