The recruit comes into the recruiting office's camp with two or three loads dressed in the hillmen's dress—a loin cloth, a thin waistcoat buttoned from throat to waist, a queer little black cap higher on one side than on the other, a sheet or blanket which serves as an overcoat. Round each lad's waist is a long strip of cloth or linen into which is stuck the kukri, the native knife which the Tommies who lined the little cliffs—that border each side of the level bit of ground at Rankhett, which is parade ground and sports ground as well—yelled with "Zam-Buk" as they picked himself up, and grinned delightedly.
