PROPOSED NEW CHARGE FOR ELECTRIC POWER.

DEPUTATION WAITS ON NORTHCOTE COUNCIL. MATTER TO BE RECONSIDERED. A deputation representing users of electric current for power purposes, on Monday evening waited on the Northcote Council to ask that they reconsider their proposal to charge for the use of electric power from 3d. to 5d. per unit.

THE ELECTRIC LIGHT BREAK-DOWN.

COMPANY'S EXPLANATION. The Melbourne Electric Supply Co. were explaining that the breakdown in the electric light night last week was due to the failure of one of the generating sets, which will, until it is replaced, be a serious drawback to the continuity of the supply. They were, however, striving every nerve to complete the erection of converting machinery ordered early in 1919, but only just recently received, which enables a supply to be taken from the electric power house at Newport. It is expected that it will be possible to turn on this supply for heating purposes, etc., within the next three or four days, and everything is all right, 7000 hours power will then become available, improving the continuity of supply. Electric security would, however, not be secured until a second machine, which is now being manufactured, which is delivered and erected, towards the purchase of a third one. Permission for the supply of further current from Newport has now been given by the electricity commissioners. When this is in position, the continuity of the supply will be brought back to its original state of reliability which obtained before war conditions intervened.

INSPECTOR TIGHE prosecuted. The defendant pleaded guilty. He was fined £5 on the first charge and £1 on the second.

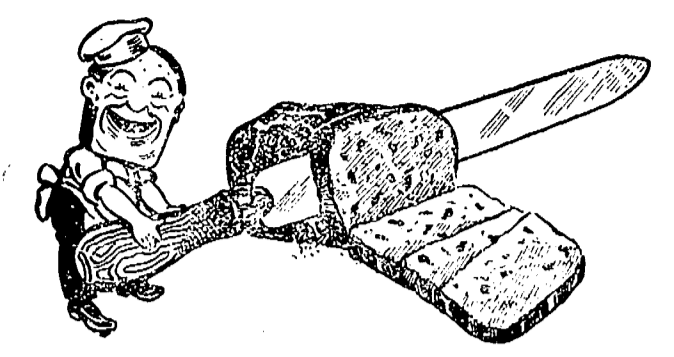
