45FT. MINIMUM FRONTAGE.

PROTEST FROM RESERVOIR PROGRESS ASSOCIATION.

At last meeting of Preston Council a letter was received from Mr. Thos. R. Clinch, secretary of Reservoir Progress Association, an emphatic protest against the increase in minimum frontages of building allotments on the following grounds:—(1) That present subdivisions did not lend themselves to subdivision to enable owners to get the best return on their outlay; that the State Savings Bank had decreed that 44 feet was the maximum frontage upon which a house of their style can be built; that it entailed extra initial expense to the prospective home owner, as the extra land would cost more; it entailed extra expense for street lighting, and it was a retrograde step that would affect the progress of this rapidly progressing portion of the city.

Cr. Jones said he was surprised that a progress association should want the minimum below 45 feet. The State Savings Bank accepted 44 feet as a minimum. It was not a retrograde step, and it appeared that these people wanted to get back to the status of Collingwood or Fitzroy. Every meeting they had applications to cut down the space between buildings. If the minimum area had been 50 feet years ago it would have been a good thing.

Cr. McPherson suggested that the writers be asked to attend the open council, and that they be given a quarter of an hour to express their views. He heard they were fully three people in this association. (Laughter.) Those people might be able to give them some information.

Cr. Robinson moved that members of the Reservoir Progress Association be invited along next committee night. A number of subdivisions had 66 feet frontages, and owners had since desired to subdivide these into 44 feet blocks.

There was no second.

Cr. McPherson moved that the Progress Association be invited along at next council meeting to express their views.

Cr. Pratt seconded, and said that the matter should be given publicity.

Cr. Jones said if the Progress Association wanted a deputation, they knew how to get one.

The amendment was lost and the letter was simply received.

SEPTIC TANKS IN UNSEWERED AREAS.

PROPOSALS OF METROPOLITAN BOARD OF WORKS.

The Preston Council has received a letter from the Metropolitan Board of Works in connection with disposal of nightsoil from unsewered areas, stating it was proposed to ask the Government to pass legislation authorising the Board to compel owners of premises, where the soil was suitable, to provide a septic tank, and where the soil was unsuitable, to provide some other treatment or disposal approved by the Board, and where owners fail the Board to carry out the work under a system of deferred payments extending over five years.

Cr. Jones said the Board meant to operate on the outlying parts of the municipality. The cost of each septic system, exclusive of the sewerage fittings, would be £10, and the sewerage fittings would be suitable for the sewerage when it came. The cost could be spread over five years, and the yearly cost would then be only £2, or about the same as the sanitary rate. Areas would not be treated that would be likely to come under a sewerage area at an early date.

The letter was received.

OBJECTION TO SUNDAY SPORT.

The Preston Council has received a letter from Rev. F. Delbridge, chairman South Preston Methodist Circuit, a resolution "That this quarterly meeting of South Preston Methodist Circuit strongly disapproves of the use of municipal reserves for Sunday games."

Cr. Robinson moved that the matter go to the inspector. The council did not countenance Sunday sport.

Cr. Jones said the council had already carried a resolution prohibiting Sunday games.

Cr. McPherson moved an amendment that the matter go to committee, and the writer be asked where the Sunday sport took place.

The motion was withdrawn and the amendment was carried.


