When he went to their assistance when the defendant came forward Barnett used an insulting expression. Barnett said, "I'm a bit of a fool. I am drinking with that man. This afternoon and I see a bit excited."
Fined 5s.
Failed to Lodge Tax Return
William Buchanan, of Thornbury, pleaded guilty to a charge of having failed to lodge an income tax return. He was fined 10s.
Debt
Jaeger and Weber, for whom Mr. R. R. Gray appeared, obtained an order against A. Riley for £87.7, with 18s 6d costs.
Man on Bay Charges
L. Sheehan, Barry, 21 years, was charged with being on November 30 assaulted Constable Buchanan in the execution of his duty, with having refused to obey a lawful order, and with being insolent and using obscene language.
Constable Buchanan said that the Carlton Hotel in Separation Street and that he and Sheehan were out of an area there. An argument started and Buchanan used force. They did not hit one another, but Sheehan went on to the other side of the street where a crowd gathered. Witnesses arrested the man and defendant. Sheehan refused to allow him to release the prisoner. He began to struggle with the witness, who had begun to kick and struggle and use force. Sheehan was arrested and finally the defendant was taken to the police station. Constable Buchanan, who was in the street, was injured to the extent of £2 10s.
Constable Buchanan gave similar evidence and said that Barry struggled and used force and language all the time when he was taken to the watch-house.
Defendant, who admitted many previous convictions, was dealt with as follows: 12 months imprisonment, and 12 months in default, and 12 months in default for the assault.
Claim for Board
Edith Oakford proceeded against James Oakford claiming £12 for board and lodging.
Mr. R. R. Gray appeared for the defendant.
Mrs. Oakford said the period covered was from August to the amount claimed was at the rate of 20 per week.
Oakford said the complainant was his stepmother. He assessed the period during which he had no board as 18 weeks. He got out of one of his rooms on the 1st of the month, but he had no board. During the time he was out of work the value of the board and lodging would be as given in a week. He had paid £5 in board and lodging and was prepared to pay £12 to settle the debt.
The judge made a compromise to £10 for both parties.

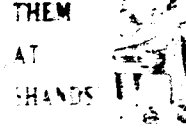
