## EXIT HOUSING COMMISSION

### "LEADER-BUDGET" ACTION APPLAUDED

THERE were many expressions of satisfaction at the monthly meeting of the North Ward Progress Association at the decision of the State Government not to proceed further with the purchase of the old Fitzroy racecourse in St. George's Road on which to build Housing Commission homes.

The president of the Association (Mr. T. J. McMahon) was not present, but he forwarded a report of the proceedings of the deputation to the Premier on the matter and stated how pleased citizens must be—and especially those residing in the vicinity of the site—at the ultimate result of their protests.

**SCHEME ECONOMICALLY UNSOUND**  
Mr. S. J. Simpson, who was a member of the deputation, said no attempt had been made to condemn the Housing Commission, the endeavor being to point out that the site was not a suitable one to which the Commission could extend its activities and generally the scheme was uneconomic and unsafe. They were under a debt of gratitude to Mr. McMahon for the energy and initiative he had shown and he deserved the thanks of every citizen. In moving that the meeting convey to the proprietors of the "Leader-Budget" its best thanks for its excellent support in opposition to the proposition, Mr. Simpson said there had been no beating about the bush on the part of the "Budget," which had come right out into the open, and told the Commission where it stood and what the residents of Northcote thought. Too much credit could not be given the "Budget."

**"BUDGET" SUPPORT APPRECIATED**  
Cr. A. C. Bird said members of the Northcote City Council were delighted with the result. It had been stressed at council meetings how great had been the support given by the Association, and the value of the petition, which had been presented to the Premier carrying 2100 signatures. It had meant much laborious work on the part of the ladies and the others who had secured the signatures. But after all, they had got their reward and every minute spent in that way had been valuable.

Then again, said Cr. Bird, they had the 100 per cent support of the "Leader-Budget" which was a most popular journal and exercised a tremendous amount of influence for good in the City. Having a huge circulation and finding its way into every home, it could be assumed that the "Budget" was read by over 30,000 people and had been a service of inspiration. In condemning the proposition, the attitude of the "Budget" had not been abusive. The articles had been true and reliable and direct to the point. Fresh facts had constantly been elucidated in the campaign by the "Budget" and these had been forcefully placed in a proper sequence which had been much appreciated even by people living in other Wards. One of their own members, and the representative of the "Budget," Mr. A. S. McNabb, had to be credited with a certain amount of what occurred. It was pleasing to know that they had in the municipality such a progressive journal with men of the calibre of Mr. McNabb on its staff. They all appreciated the interest Mr. McNabb took in local matters and looked upon him as an asset to the city. As an ex-mayor of the city, he could say that other ex-mayors valued Mr. McNabb's assistance. Everything went to show that when they had a good case it must be prosecuted with vigor and courage.

In acknowledging the sentiments Mr. McNabb said he would convey the information to the proprietors of the "Leader-Budget" whose policy it was to do everything possible for the progress and development of the City. It had hardly been necessary to say that after Cr. Bird's eulogy.

The chairman (Mr. Cross) who was also a member of the deputation, said he came away firmly convinced they had an excellent chance of getting what they wanted. Messrs. McMahon and Simpson had excelled themselves on the way they had put their views.

Mr. C. Gorman (secretary and also a member of the delegation) said that Cr. T. W. Andrews, of Preston, had put up a vigorous fight on behalf of the retention of the Jeanes' estate at Preston, and had brought under the Premier's notice many anomalies of the Slum Abolition Act which were due to be removed. He was grateful to all those who had assisted in securing the signatures to the petition.
