## TOWN HALL SENDS OUT A CALL TO DUTY

### EVERYONE CAN HELP!

THE nearer the war comes to the shores of Australia the more urgent becomes the call to duty and self-sacrifice on the part of every resident of Northcote. 1942 has broken in on us as a Commonwealth more ominously than any of its predecessors, because the danger from personal violence has never been so great.
