Labor Again Successful

In Northcote Council Elections

TWO RETIRING COUNCILLORS DEFEATED
NARROW WIN FOR CR. JONES

The sweeping Labor success at the Federal polls was reflected in the result of the Northcote Municipal elections conducted on Thursday last. Fought in three wards the battle was conducted on straight out political grounds and resulted in two retiring councillors, Cr. F. Capp (North Ward) and Cr. A. McAdam (South Ward), being defeated and Cr. M. C. Jones (East Ward) winning narrowly by 12 votes.

The two new councillors, both endorsed Labor men, are Cr. T. Walsh and Cr. C. A. Lavars. Mr. Alex Smith gave his opponent an exceptionally close contest and can be said to have lost the seat by the postal voting details of which are appended hereunder.

Tribute must be paid to Cr. Capp for the magnificent spirit with which he accepted his defeat. He was among the very first to shake Mr. Walsh by the hand and proffer his congratulations. It was a splendid gesture and indicative of the man. More will be heard of Fred Capp. Ex Cr. McAdam deserves the thanks of the City for his labors. His defeat was not a sign of lack of confidence in him as a councillor, but was the result of a political upheaval during which he simply happened to be on the losing side. STRONG PROTEST AGAINST PASSING-OVER OF WEST WARD COUNCILLORS

£275 ALLOWANCE—A DRY CUPBOARD

At the statutory meeting of the Northcote Council held at the Town Hall on Monday, August 30 at 10 a.m. Cr. H. W. Shewan (Central Ward) was elected Mayor of Northcote for 1943-4. The election was not without incident and the vote (purely on party lines, according to one interjector) was 9-5 in Cr. Shewan's favor. Cr. W. E. Findlay (West Ward) was the other nominee.

All councillors were in attendance excepting Cr. Gill, who was unavoidably absent. Cr. W. Glasgow took the chair. Cr. W. Oliver moved and Cr. French seconded that the mayoral allowance be fixed at £275.

In moving an amendment that the amount be fixed at £350 Cr. W. Turner said that no councillor elected to the office of mayor of a city as important as Northcote should be expected to fitly support such an office out of his own pocket. He definitely asserted that £275 was not nearly enough for the purpose. Certainly such a low allowance militated against the appointment of a Labor councillor. However the amendment was lost and the allowance was fixed at £275.

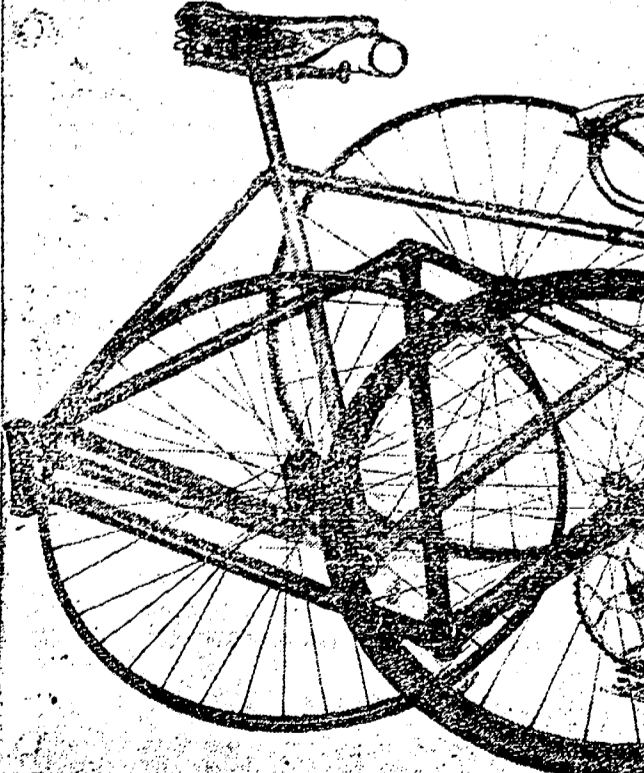
